#### Introduction

Attorneys are among the most conservative of professionals. They tend to lag when it comes to using new technology. In the early 2000s, for example, attorneys were seen as slow to embrace the computer age.

It has been more than a decade and it seems the legal profession are well on their way to embracing the usage of computer systems. In fact, some law firms have large IT departments fully devoted to managing computer networks that allow lawyers and their clients to smoothly communicate and exchange data through the use of computers. However, the perception is that lawyers are still lagging behind in the adoption of state-of-the-art secure data protection systems. Lawyers are still viewed as obstinate, clinging to the opinion that security breaches "can't happen here."

Unfortunately, because of their lax data security systems, law firms are favorite targets of even junior-grade hackers although breaches on law firms are seldom reported because of possible damage to their reputations and loss of confidence from their clients—notwithstanding the fact that more and more governments are enacting data breach notification laws.

Even websites for fictitious lawyers are not exempt from hacking and defacement. What makes solo attorneys and law firms attractive hacking targets? Money. Big corporations hire attorneys to advise on huge deals which are attractive targets for business espionage. Solo family lawyers are often hired by estranged couples on divorce proceedings—often involving huge sums, the details of which are often shared confidentially with attorneys.

Attorneys are made privy to secrets worth fortunes as trustees, or patent or trade secret attorneys. Confidential information held by trial lawyers about their clients are also particularly attractive to those very much interested in landing those clients in jail—for better or for worse. The bottom-line is, lawyers and law firms who don't have secure data protection systems in place are ripe for the picking by hackers.





Strongly encrypted storage media and files are useless to hackers. Accordingly, what they target instead are the authentication systems and the passwords used on them.

There are three factors of authentication commonly recognized:

- 1. Something You Know user name and password combination
- 2. **Something You Have** Any advise you have (sometimes throughout your network session) in order to be authenticated—like badges, tokens, key dongles, or ATM cards.
- 3. Something You Are fingerprint or voice print.

There's a fourth factor increasingly being proposed, Somewhere You Are, or simply location. This is an additional authorization factor that can help curb fraud. The more authentication a data protection solution uses, the more secure it is thought to be. However, more factors means greater inconvenience and therefore multi-factor authentication solutions are used for accessing highly sensitive data and systems.

#### Case Scenario

A 15-year-old law firm sought to upgrade its security procedures after a minor data intrusion incident. With the goal being 100% elimination of data intrusion vulnerabilities, the senior partners conducted an internal audit of the current security systems in place including the necessary forensics to understand the basis of the data intrusion incident. Their conclusion was that the intrusion was limited as the data encryption, admin monitoring and vigilance systems were sufficient at the senior executive level of the organisation. However, at the staff and junior partner level, several data entry intrusion points were identified primarily because of usage of a simple username and password combination. This necessitated the senior partners to introduce a strong authentication process so that all data risks could either be eliminated or mitigated throughout the organisation.

Senior management then commissioned a taskforce to evaluate authentication solutions and their vendors. The taskforce findings showed the most suitable authentication system for the law firm's purpose was a multi-factor electronic hardware token system capable of keeping digital certificates and generating time-based one-time passwords. After looking up several well-respected vendors in the authentication business, the taskforce recommended Maverick Secure LLC's, the Maverick 4-F<sup>TM</sup> security authentication system.

# The Challenge

Deploying a new security authentication system to a group of lawyers would need to take into account their workflow so their productivity and efficiency (and billable hours) were not impacted.







# **Key Requirements**

- Strong authentication System should be able to use multi-factors, depending on the user's access level.
- Easy to use Lawyers are not known for being technologically savvy.
- Easy to implement and manage – Simplicity in administration will drive down costs.



#### **Mayerick Solution**

After reviewing solutions offered by several well-respected vendors in the rapidly developing authentication market, the senior partners chose the Maverick 4-F<sup>TM</sup>, regarded as a breakthrough 4-factor password system.

The Maverick 4-F<sup>TM</sup> is a hybrid security token system featuring zero end user driver installation, Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) capabilities and time-limited one-time passwords (OTPs) generated every few minutes.

The security token further protects data and is easier to use by being compatible with many encryption, authentication, and access gateway technologies approved at government level. The Maverick 4-FTM's PKI functions enable encrypted digital certificates to validate the identity of the user (and the server) continuously while on the firm's LAN or VPN remote connection.

# **Implementation**

Fortunately, the law firm consisted only of four senior partners and 20 junior lawyers under them, plus 30 support staff. Maintenance services had limited access to the firm's LAN (mostly email, Internet and a few desktop games while they were not on active duty) so the deployment targeted only the lawyers, their assistants and secretaries who had the necessary clearance to access sensitive client information.

To encourage the lawyers to use the security tokens, a two-week pilot testing was given to the most promising up-and-coming junior partners. Success of the pilot after two weeks inspired others to use the tokens as well. Those two weeks were also devoted to refining the solution by the deployment team.



#### Results

#### 1. Data Protection and Peace of Mind

The senior partners had greater confidence that their clients' data was secure and that any work performed on the client files by junior partners and staff were safe from any data intrusion.

# 2. No Impact on Staff Workflow

Due to the simplicity of implementation, the workflow of all the inhouse legal teams was uninterrupted which meant that normal billing and processes continued as normal.

#### 3. Easier IT Management

Maverick 4-F's web-based admin tools made it easy for the legal firm's IT team to adminster the activation, revocation of security tokens and monitoring of access of the firm's LAN.

# Summary

The new security authentication system had the desired effect on staff, junior partners and clients whereby there was greater overall confidence that client data was secured from end to end while it reposed in the legal firm's IT systems. It led to a greater morale across the board within the firm and had the added unseen benefit whereby the firm was recommended through word-of-mouth promotion by their clients to other businesses who were seeking legal assistance.
